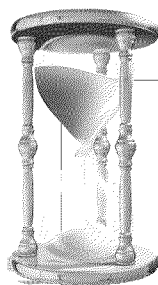

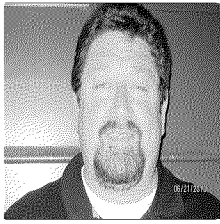

One evening our local missions president, Loraine Darby, invited only our folks who had a birthday from January to June to go to a room where there were some refreshments prepared while the rest of us were left wondering why we had been left out. She then shared a missions lesson at Plaza that spoke of the "forgotten ones." The forgotten ones are the people that have been left out, overlooked, or ignored by the church. We are called to *Make Christlike Disciples in the Nations* and that includes the places where we serve. The forgotten ones don't just live somewhere else; they live in our neighborhoods. They are the ones we pass everyday on our way to work. They are the ones who live next door. In the parable of the Sheep and Goats (Matthew 25) Jesus identifies with the forgotten ones when he says, "I was a stranger and you did not invite me in."

The gospel has not left out anyone- it is for the Jew and the Gentile, male and female, young and old. Evangelism is the process by which we share the gospel. The forgotten ones are the people who need to hear the gospel. Let's make a concerted effort to look around and notice the forgotten ones in our communities. Then, let's reach out and minister to them.

O' by the way, following the lesson, we all were invited to enjoy the refreshments and no one was forgotten.
